DSC INTERIM JUDGMENT

The Court finds that the defendant, has pled \_\_\_\_\_ to the above offense and waived his/her right to a jury trial and after being duly sworn upon his/her oath stated that the following statements are true.

DEFENDANT'S AFFIDAVIT

I am requesting the court to defer proceedings in this cause for a period of ninety (90) days to allow me to complete a driving safety course approved under the Texas Driver and Traffic Education Act (Article 4413 [29c]), V.T.C.S. I state under oath that am not in the process of taking a driving safety course under Article 45.0511 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, nor have I completed a course within one year immediately preceding the date of issuance of the above style and numbered citation, nor have I completed a course that is not yet reflected on my driving record as maintained by the Texas Department of Public Safety. I certify that I am not a holder of a commercial driver's license.

In the event I the Defendant fail to timely satisfy any requirement of this order, I PROMISE TO APPEAR in the DeSoto Municipal Court at 211 E. Pleasant Run Road, DeSoto, Texas 75115 at 10:30am on the next business day immediately following \_\_\_\_\_ to Showcause why I failed to fulfill the terms of my Driver's Safety Course Agreement. I understand that if I fail to appear that a warrant may be issued for my arrest. I certify that I understand all of the instructions as set out.

The Court finds that the Defendant meets the requirements for taking a driving safety course and IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED, that in accordance with Article 45.0511 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, no judgment shall be entered in this cause and that a disposition of guilt is deferred in this cause for a period of 90 days from the date of the plea is entered. Furthermore, Defendant must comply with the following conditions:

- 1. Immediately make payment of court costs and \$10.00 nonrefundable administrative fee totaling \_\_\_\_\_
2. Provide proof of a valid Texas driver's license or permit, or proof of being a member, or the spouse or dependent child of a member, of the United States military forces serving on active duty.
3. Provide proof of financial responsibility (vehicle liability insurance).
4. Attend a Driver's Safety Course and Submit a uniform certificate of course completion as well as file with the court a certified copy of his/her driving record from the Texas Department of Public Safety by \_\_\_\_\_.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, at the conclusion of the deferral period, Defendant shall present satisfactory evidence that he/she has complied with the requirements imposed. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the complaint shall be dismissed and there shall be no final conviction. If no satisfactory evidence is presented, and following a show cause hearing, disposition of guilt can be entered and a fine imposed, the imposition constituting a final conviction of Defendant.

## **DRIVING SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

The following are your instructions for taking a Driving Safety Course. Please read and follow all the instructions.

### **Your due date is listed on the DSC Interim Judgment and No Extension Will Be Granted For Completion Of The Driving Safety Course**

1. **You make your own arrangements to attend a driving safety school.** You may take the 6-to-8 hour course at any Texas Education Agency approved school. There are many schools offering courses in the immediate area, consult your telephone directory under “Driving Schools”. The course will also be available on the Internet. Check <http://www4.esc13.net/drivers/> for a list of approved courses.
2. Request a Certified Copy of your Driving Record **IMMEDIATELY**. The form can be ordered by contacting Texas Department of Public Safety at 1-(512)-424-2000 or a local Department of Public Safety. You may also request your Driving Record online at [www.texasonline.com](http://www.texasonline.com). After you have filled out your information, select **Type 3A: Certified List of All Accident and Violations in Record**.

**DO NOT WAIT FOR THE DRIVING RECORD BEFORE TAKING THE CLASS.**

**ALL INQUIRIES REGARDING YOUR DRIVING RECORD SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.**

3. To have your ticket dismissed, you are required to furnish the Court with the following documentation within the 90-days shown on the DSC Interim Judgment.
  - A. Uniform Certificate of Completion (indicating successful completion of a driving safety course). Certificate of Completion shows COURT COPY on the form.
  - B. Certified copy of your driving record from DPS Austin.
  - C. Upon satisfactory completion of a driving safety course and submission of the required documentation, the case will be forwarded to a Judge for dismissal and the offense will not be reported on your driving record.
