PARENT TIP

Bathtime and hand washing can sometimes be a challenge for active kids who don't like to stop the fun of their current activity. Turn bathing and washing hands more exciting with bubbles!

An easy way to make HUGE bubbles is to make a bubble solution of water, dishsoap, and sugar (or corn syrup) and use with homemade bubble windows made with string and straws.
