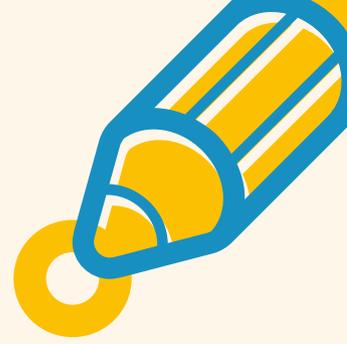

PARENT TIP
