- IPS is responsible for submitting the Request for Proposals (RFPs) to Blane Riddings and the Parks department for their review and feedback.
- Following the receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP), Manhattan Construction will initiate the awarding of Letter of Intent (LOI) contracts.
- The city's building inspection department will maintain collaboration with IPS to review and approve architectural and engineering drawings.
- Smith Group is set to submit Addendum 4 to IPS, which will then disseminate the information as needed.
- The upcoming Fitness Equipment meeting will be guided by Smith Group, with Melvin Sanders acting as the consulting expert.

- IPS has completed a comprehensive review of the entire project budget, which is derived from aggregated figures.

- The ARC team has conducted a walkthrough to identify confirmed and potential LEED points, emphasizing the significance of monitoring progress and maintaining reports during the construction phase.
